All Purpose Cleaner
1 tsp dish soap
1 cup water



Fire Ant Mound Drench
3 TBS orange oil
6 TBS water



Tub & Shower Cleaner

1/4 cup dish soap

1/4 cup baking soda

2 TBS hydrogen
peroxide



Glass Cleaner
1 part vinegar
1 part water

1 gallon water



Orange oil Cleaner & Degreaser

1/8 tsp orange oil

1 cup water



Insecticidal Soap

1 TBS Castille soap

1 tsp apple cider
vinegar
4 cups filtered or
distilled water

## Clean and Disinfect your Kitchen

- All-purpose cleaner
  - o 1 tsp dish soap
  - o 2 cups of water
- Glass cleaner
  - o 1 part vinegar
  - o 1 part water
- Disinfectants
  - o Rubbing alcohol, 65%-90%
    - 30 second dwell time
  - Hydrogen peroxide
    - 1-5 minute dwell time
- Orange oil cleaner and degreaser
  - o 2 ounces cold pressed orange oil
  - 1 gallon of water
  - Or, 1/8 tsp orange oil to 1 cup of water
- DIY orange cleaner
  - o Fill a jar with a tight-fitting lid with orange peels and white vinegar for 30 days.
- Fire ant mound drench
  - o 3 TBS orange oil
  - o 6 TBS water
  - o 1 gallon water
- Mesh sink strainers

## Bathroom Shine on a Dime

- Tub and shower cleaner
  - o ¼ cup dish soap
  - o ¼ cup baking soda
  - 2 TBS hydrogen peroxide
- Grout cleaner baking soda applied with a damp toothbrush

### Laundry Hacks

- Borax is a natural deodorizer that also softens the water and boosts the cleaning power of your detergent
- Wool dryer balls with essential oils instead of fabric softener

## Organic Fertilizers and Compost

- Always follow the directions on fertilizers, herbicides, and pesticides
  - Don't apply more than recommended
  - Don't apply on a windy day
  - o Don't apply before a rain or lawn sprinklers go off
- Fill raised bed or pots with half compost and half soil
- Compost methods
  - Compost ball
  - Compost tumbler
  - o Hot
  - o Cold
  - o Bokashi
  - Vermicompost

## **Organic Pest Control**

- Water to remove aphids
- Mosquito dunks in standing water
- BT for caterpillars
- Insecticidal soap
  - o 1 TBS Castille soap
  - 4 cups filtered or distilled water
  - o Optional: 1 tsp apple cider vinegar

#### Weed Control

- Pull by hand when the soil is moist
- Horticultural vinegar for broadleaf weeds

## Pest Control Part 2

- BT for squash bugs and squash vine borers
- Diatomaceous Earth for hard bodied insects including ants, fleas and ticks
- Demonstration of orange oil fire ant mound drench
